

New Futures Programme

The New Futures programme is led by Greenbank College in partnership with VOLA, a consortium of voluntary community enterprise organisations. The programme offers support to people who are aged 16 – 24 and not in education, employment or training (NEET) or are 15 – 24 and at risk of becoming NEET. It is intended to be a stepping stone for those who are not yet ready to move into employment, training or further education.

Participants will be given a comprehensive information, advice and guidance assessment and a personalised action plan.

A personalised action plan could include:

- Accredited or non-accredited course
- Work related course tasters
- English and Maths
- Employability skills
- Work placement opportunities
- Advice and support from employers

Key Workers work closely with participants to offer mentoring and support. This support will continue after progression to employment, further education, an apprenticeship or a traineeship.

Reviews will take place regularly to ensure personal targets are met and progression routes are achieved.
