The sports 4 all sports club gives young people with a disability the chance to join in various sports on an equal level.

The club is for young people age 5-18 from Halton and operates from both Widnes and Runcorn.

The club promotes and develops sports skills and no prior experience is required, it also supports those who wish to join local sports clubs.

Volunteer support is utilised within the club in supporting those members who need extra support to take part and all volunteers and coaches receive assistance guidance and coaching qualification opportunities within the club.

The club is based on the key principles of every child matters charter and we have policy documents on all the key areas needed for the running of a club.

A variety of sports are available and all members take an active role in choosing the activities on offer to them.

All sessions are coached by qualified coaches and all hold a valid CRB check. Many partners have been involved in this project including Sport England and Halton Partnership, who currently provide some funding for the club. The club also receives ongoing support from Access to Sport Forum and Halton Borough Council.
