

Multi-sensory handwriting activity

1. Scribe the letter using a whiteboard pen so that the child can see how you have written it. Talk through how you are writing it, emphasising that you have started on the line and then ask them where they should start from before they write.

Next ask the child to write over your letter while saying the letter name. Do not rub this out.

2. When the child is successful with step 1, then ask the child to copy the letter while saying the letter name as they write.
3. Next, boxes 1&2 must be covered and the child must write the letter from memory while saying the name.
4. Finally, the child must close their eyes and write the letter while saying the letter name.
5. Repeat as necessary - frequently check correct orientation in writing books.
