

CBB Employment Support

Community Bridge Building Employment Support Team is a service provided by Halton Borough Council; we are looking for local businesses in the Halton area that may benefit from volunteer workers.

We provide full job coaching and training for new volunteers to assist them in gaining the knowledge and skills needed to work independently in any employment setting. Our service helps and supports people with disabilities, mental health issues and carers in Halton in finding opportunities in voluntary work, permitted and paid work.



We work with clients on a one to one basis over a number of weeks to ensure that they are fully equipped with the skills needed to carry out work tasks that are expected of them in their working role. The service is not long term, however we will support someone for as long as it takes for them and the employer to feel comfortable in the client working independently; we will then provide ongoing support to the person and the employer to ensure a successful long term placement.

CBB Employment Support Team is asking for local businesses to offer trial placements for a number of weeks to our clients. We believe that with our support the client could be a real asset to your team. For some of our success stories please contact our team for further information booklet.
