



## **Halton's MAX Card Scheme?**

# What is it?

The Max Card is a discount card for families of disabled children that can be used at various leisure and holiday activities across Britain. The scheme is designed to help families save money on great days out at castles, zoos, bowling alleys and more.

Halton has registered with this national scheme in the hope that some activities may be more affordable for families.

#### Who can have a card?

We are offering this to families of disabled children aged 0-18 years who live in Halton. The card cannot be passed on to be used by another individual or family.

### How can I get a card?

They are available from Halton's Disabled Children Service at <a href="DCS@halton.gov.uk">DCS@halton.gov.uk</a> or call **0151 511 6560.** 

You will be asked to provide the following details - your name, your child's name and date of birth and your home address including postcode to register with the scheme. The signature for the main carer is required by DCS when you receive your card.

#### How much do they cost?

The cards are £2.50p each which covers the full cost that Halton Borough Council pays to the scheme. It is valid for 2 years and so those using the card will probably cover their costs the first time that they use it.
