Short Breaks Service for Children with Disabilities

Who are we and what do we do

We provide short breaks to children with a disability age 0-18 to enable parents/carers to continue with their caring role.

Short breaks provide families with the opportunity to access activities away from the mundane of everyday life.



Referrals

Parents/carers can make a referral via the Halton Contact Centre; 0151 907-8305.

Professionals can make a referral via iCart with consent from person with parental responsibility.

Eligibility criteria

Children age 0-18 with a diagnosis of one or more of the following conditions;

- Hearing impairment
- Visual impairment
- Learning disability
- Physical disability
- Chronic or life threatening
 physical illness
- Communication disorder (including Autism)
- Consciousness disorder
- Mental health

All children must have a current EHCP in place.
