We look forward to welcoming you to one of our training events in the near future.









TALK EAL (An Introduction to English as an Additional Language)	An introduction to what it means to be bilingual, the typical pattern of learning English as an Additional Language, and ways for practition to support this.

TALK Adult-Child Interaction	A look at the importance of adult interaction in children's language learning, the impact these have and how to improve the quality of your own adult-child interactions.			
TALK Environments	A look at the importance of the physical environment on communication and what makes a 'Total Communication' setting/environment.			
TALK Social Communication in the Early Years	A claiming video cooking at sociat communication in the Early reals. This claiming session aims to answer the following questions.			
TALK Visual Supports	A look at a range of visual supports which can be used to support children at universal, targeted and specialist levels.			
TALK Transitions	A look at the range of transitions children experience and how they can impact children. This session also looks at a range of strategies to support transitions, including visual supports.			
WellComm Training	An overview of the Early Years WellComm Screening Toolkit, including why early identification and intervention is important, how to complete screenings and what to do next. This training video will be useful for practitioners who are new to the toolkit and also as a refresher.  Walkthrough videos, with useful hints and tips are also able for each section of the WellComm screening.




